

## **Data Sharing / Data Availability Policy**

### **Journal of Clinical Electrophysiology & Wound Management (JCEWM)**

#### **1. Transparency and Reproducibility**

JCEWM supports transparency and reproducibility in research. Authors are encouraged to make underlying data available whenever ethically and legally permissible.

---

#### **2. Data Availability Statement**

All submitted manuscripts must include a **Data Availability Statement** indicating:

- Whether data are publicly available
- The repository name (if applicable)
- Persistent identifiers (e.g., DOI, accession number)
- Conditions for access (if restricted)

Example statements:

- “The datasets generated during the current study are available in [repository name], [DOI/accession number].”
  - “Data are available from the corresponding author upon reasonable request.”
  - “Data sharing is not applicable to this article as no new data were created.”

#### **3. Data Repositories**

Authors are encouraged to deposit data in recognized, discipline-appropriate repositories that provide persistent identifiers and long-term access.

---

#### **4. Clinical Trial Registration**

Prospective clinical trials must be registered in a publicly accessible registry prior to enrollment of participants. Registration numbers must be included in the manuscript.

---

#### **5. Ethical and Legal Limitations**

Data containing personally identifiable information must be de-identified in accordance with privacy regulations before sharing. If data cannot be shared due to ethical or legal constraints, authors must state this clearly.
