***“Neuromusculoskeletal Ultrasound Imaging”***

Ultrasound imaging is rapidly growing field across specialties and is known to be superior to other imaging techniques in terms of cost-effectiveness, higher patient satisfaction, multiplanar capability, time savings, and overall efficiency in patient care. There is a special area within diagnostic ultrasound imaging for neuromusculoskeletal imaging which is rapidly growing and has wide range of applications, such as a point-of-care assessment tool for musculoskeletal conditions or as an adjunct to electrodiagnostic tests. Real-time ultrasound imaging enhances the understanding of the soft tissue structures when used as an extension to physical examination.
